

Complex Maternal-Newborn Care Management

The clinical management of maternal-newborn care is becoming more complex and resource intensive. In many instances, health plans and employers have a disproportionate share of these costs with as much as 60% of their claims being related to the maternal-newborn period. Conditions identified in the neonatal period are also among the most expensive diagnoses.

Nearly half of the hospital charges for all births – over \$18.1 billion – were for infants with a diagnosis of prematurity or low birth weight. Consider that an infant without complications costs an average of \$1,700, while an infant born prematurely or at low a birth weight costs an average of \$77,000.*

Between 1998 and 2008, the rate of infants born preterm in the United States increased 6%. In 2008, 12.3% of live births were born preterm.

The rate of preterm birth in the United States is highest for black infants (18.1%), followed by Native Americans (14.1%), Hispanics (12.2%), whites (11.4%) and Asians (10.8%). Compared with singleton births (one baby), multiple births in the United States were about 6 times as likely to be preterm in 2008.**

Standard care management programs and traditional methods of managing care for these high risk cases are not enough. A comprehensive program that integrates maternal and newborn management with financial claims analysis and resolution offers superior outcomes and bottom line results.
